SUBSTITUTIONS of Junior Showmanship dogs must be made at least one half hour prior to the judging of any Junior Showmanship classes at the show.

For Puppy Dogs and Bitches - 6 to 9 and 9 to 12 months

There will be a class offered for Puppy Dogs and a class for Puppy Bitches in all breeds with a selection of Best Puppy in each breed following the judging of Best of Breed for that breed. All Best Puppy Winners will then compete in their respective group for First through Fourth Puppy in their Group. The First Place winners of the Puppy Group Competition will then compete for Best Puppy in Show.

All trophies must be picked up the day of the show. Trophies will not be mailed.

To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline (877) 252-3229.

Ramps at the sole discretion of the judge, approved breeds may be judged on the ground or on a ramp: Boykin Spaniels, Clumber Spaniels, Sussex Spaniels, Whippets, Irish Terriers, Kerry Blue Terriers, Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers, Staffordshire Bull Terriers, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei, Chow Chows, Keeshonden & Polish Lowland Sheepdogs. (Boykin Spaniels & Whippets may be judged on the table, ramp or on the ground.)

Basset Hounds are expected to be judged on the ramp during breed judging.

This list may be revised from time to time, and the current list can be found on the AKC website in Judging Operations. **A judge requesting** the use of a ramp must give reasonable notice to the Show Superintendent/Show Secretary prior to the day of the show. AKC approval is not required.

Ramps may be used in emergency situations to judge any breed. (In all but emergency situations, the exhibitor has no recourse. In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.)

NOTICE

JUNIORS WHO SUBSTITUTE FOR THE ORIGINAL DOG THEY HAVE ENTERED IN THE JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP CLASSES WITH DOGS THAT ARE NOT ENTERED IN ONE OF THE OFFERED CLASSES AT THIS SHOW MUST REMIT THE JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP ONLY ENTRY FEE WITH THEIR SUBSTITUTION.

NO PRACTICING ALLOWED IN RINGS AT ANY TIME.

Dogs May Arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. **Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.**

Judges Will Not Wait for Any Dog Holding Up a Class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

All Dogs Present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

No gasoline or diesel generators are permitted inside any building or within 100 feet of any tent in which this dog show is conducted.

As specified in Chapter 12, Section 4 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, information contained on the entry form is required to be published in the club's show catalog. This information is also subject to publication in other media.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the event's Show Committee. If because of riots, wars, strikes, civil disturbances, national emergencies, health emergencies, and the dictates of law enforcement or of the owner(s) of the grounds and/or facilities or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to, snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, heavy rains, or other circumstances including, but not limited to, the condition of the facilities or grounds and/or the ingress and egress from the grounds, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.

NOTICE: WAIVER OF RIGHTS. All persons attending these dog shows hereby waive any claim for damages against the club, its members, superintendents or facility, in the event a motor vehicle has to be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or improperly vented conditions. Anyone parking in show site parking lots must accept full responsibility for damages should this occur.

RV/MOTOR HOME PARKING

No hookups. Dry camping only. Self-contained vehicles only.

All motor homes & trailers will be parked in designated areas only: lots 4 & 5 and a portion of lot 3.

If you park in an undesignated area, you will be asked to move your vehicle.

Failure to obey parking attendants and regulations will result in an Event Committee Hearing and expulsion from the grounds without refund.

WHEN YOU SIGN THE ENTRY FORM, YOU AUTOMATICALLY AGREE TO THE FOLLOWING TERMS CONCERNING MOTELS EXTENDING THEIR PLACE TO YOU.

THE FOLLOWING RULES HAVE BEEN ESTABLISHED FOR THE GOOD OF ALL EXHIBITORS CONCERNED.

1. Plastic sheeting is to be placed under every crate in motel rooms. This will keep carpets clean & dry. Plastic sheeting for each crate will be the responsibility of each exhibitor to provide **HIS/HER** own.
2. Dogs must be crated when owner is out of the room. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
3. Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times while in the hotel, lobbies or on hotel grounds. Rooms & lobby must be kept clean of dog debris.
4. Dogs should be "exercised" in designated areas on motel premises. Every dog owner is expected to pick up after their own dog & dispose of waste in designated trash cans. It is the responsibility of the dog owner to find out from the innkeeper where these areas & cans are located.
5. Due to the severe clogging problems with the drain pipes, no dog may be bathed in the hotel.
6. Rooms will be inspected daily by members of the hotel staff & observed violations or damages will be reported to the hotel management and/or the investigative committee.
